

**TAHOE CITY PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT
TAHOE TAVERN HEIGHTS BPS/WELL REHABILITATION PROJECT**

INVITATION TO BIDDERS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Tahoe City Public Utility District will receive bids at the Office of the Clerk of the Board at the District Administration Office, P. O. Box 5249, 221 Fairway Drive, Tahoe City, California, 96145, until **11:00AM local time, Tuesday, March 30, 2010** for the above-referenced project. At said time and promptly thereafter all bids that have been duly received will be publicly opened and read aloud at said District Administrative Office.

The work to be performed consists of all labor, material, tools, equipment and incidentals necessary to construct a Booster Pump Station Building, Water Distribution Piping, Well Building Improvements, and all associated appurtenance, facilities, and accessories necessary to complete the Tahoe Tavern Heights BPS/Well Rehabilitation Project.

Per Diem wages to be paid to workers required in the performance of the Contract shall be in accordance with the General Prevailing Hourly Wage Rate Schedule as determined by the Director of Industrial Relations, which is on file in the office of the Clerk of the Board.

The Contractor shall possess a valid California Class A Contractor's license at the time of the bid award and the license shall remain in effect throughout the term of this contract.

Attention is directed to Section 3.15 STANDARD PROVISIONS of the Project Specifications regarding required qualifications of the Contractor.

A portion of this Project is federally-funded using the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) funds administered by the United States Forest Service (USFS). Attention is directed to the Special Provisions for additional requirements related to this funding source.

Special attention is directed to the Special Provisions regarding the Buy-American requirements and the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) participation on this Project.

The Engineer's Estimate is \$ 940,000.

Contract documents for use in preparing bids may be obtained from the District Clerk at the non-refundable cost of \$50.00.


Bids must be made on the official Bid Proposal Form furnished with the contract documents. Each bid shall be accompanied by a bid bond consisting of certified check, cashiers check, or satisfactory corporate surety bid bond for not less than ten percent (10%) of the bid amount and made payable to Tahoe City Public Utility District. Each sealed envelope containing a Bid must be plainly marked on the outside as Bid for Tahoe City Public Utility District, (Project Name), and the envelope should bear on the outside, the name, address and contractor's license number of the Bidder.

District reserves the right to accept the lowest responsible bid, to reject any or all bids, or to waive any informalities or irregularities in the bid process. Bids must remain valid for a period of 45 days following the bid opening, and award of the bid is subject to the availability of funds.

A PRE-BID CONFERENCE AND SITE VISIT TO DISCUSS THE PROJECT IS SCHEDULED ON Tuesday, March 9, 2010, AT 2:00PM, in the TCPUD Administrative Office, 221 Fairway Drive, Tahoe City, California. All prospective bidders are **REQUIRED** to attend.
